

Privacy Policy

Thank you for choosing to be part of our community at Gideon Games (“Company”, “we”, “us”, or “our”). We are committed to protecting your personal information and your right to privacy. If you have any questions or concerns about this privacy policy, or our practices with regards to your personal information, please contact us at nathan@gideon-games.com.

When you use our mobile application (“App”), we appreciate that you are trusting us with your personal information. We take your privacy very seriously. In this privacy policy, we seek to explain to you in the clearest way possible what information we collect, how we use it and what rights you have in relation to it. We hope you take some time to read through it carefully, as it is important. If there are any terms in this privacy policy that you do not agree with, please discontinue use of our App or Services immediately.

This privacy policy applies to all information collected through our mobile application as well as any related other services or events.

1. What information do we collect?

In Short: We collect information that you provide to us.

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when you participate in activities on the App or otherwise when you contact us.

The personal information we collect may include the following:

- usernames
- group names
- group scores
- mail address (only when you contact us by mail)
- full name (only when you contact us by mail)

2. How do we use your information?

In Short: We process your information for your account management, to enable user-to-user communications and to request your feedback.

We use the information we collect or receive:

- To facilitate account creation and logon process.
- To manage user accounts. We may use your information for the purposes of managing our account and keeping it in working order.
- To enable user-to-user communications. We may use your information in order to enable user-to-user communications with each user's consent.

- Request feedback. We may use your information to request feedback and to contact you about your use of our App. We only request feedback when you contact us by mail.

3. Will your information be shared with anyone?

In Short: We only share information with your consent, to comply with laws, to provide you with services, to protect your rights, or to fulfill business obligations.

We may process or share your data that we hold based on the following legal basis:

- Consent: We may process your data if you have given us specific consent to use your personal information in a specific purpose.
- Legal Obligations: We may disclose your information where we are legally required to do so in order to comply with applicable law, governmental requests, a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process, such as in response to a court order or a subpoena (including in response to public authorities to meet national security or law enforcement requirements).
- Performance of a Contract: Where we have entered into a contract with you, we may process your personal information to fulfill the terms of our contract.
- Legitimate Interests: We may process your data when it is reasonably necessary to achieve our legitimate business interests.
- Vital Interests: We may disclose your information where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.

More specifically, we may need to process your data or share your personal information in the following situations:

- Business Transfers. We may share or transfer your information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.

4. How long do we keep your information?

In Short: We keep your information for no longer than 1 year unless otherwise required by law.

No purpose in this policy will require us keeping your personal information for longer than 1 year, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymize such information, or, if this is not possible then we will securely store your personal information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible.

5. What are your privacy rights?

In Short: You have full rights according to the General Data Protection Regulation.

The GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) provides the following rights for individuals regarding to their privacy rights:

- The right to be informed
- The right of access
- The right to rectification
- The right to erasure
- The right to restrict processing
- The right to data portability
- The right to object
- Rights in relation to automated decision making and profiling

If we are relying on your consent to process your personal information, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Please use the contact details provided below.
